Ani-Meals & Kibble & Litter Pantry

Our Ani-Meals program targets citizens with disabilities and those who are homebound. Food and supplies are delivered to the home once a month. Program enrollees **MUST** meet specific criteria to take part in this program.

Our Kibble & Litter Pantry is for those who are unable to afford food and services for their pet but have transportation and are able to pick up their food and supplies at a convenient location. Program enrollees **MUST** meet specific criteria to take part in this program.

Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinics

Our low-cost spay/neuter program is held once a month at a convenient location and is available to everyone. A licensed veterinarian provides these services. All cats are welcome and we also partner with a local vet clinic to provide spay and neuter services to dogs.

Vaccination and Microchip Clinics

A licensed veterinarian is on-site providing low-cost vaccinations, nail trims, dewormer, flea and tick treatment, and microchipping. Please contact us for clinic dates and locations.

Adoption Options

When all other avenues have been exhausted and the owner is no longer able to care for the pet, our no-kill organization allows for foster families to care for the pet while they await their new furever home. All pets are spayed or neutered, and vaccinated before adoption. Microchips are available upon request.
