WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO



We are a 501 (c)(3) animal welfare non-profit, run entirely by volunteers. Our skilled and educated staff are dedicated to assisting families, elderly, and disabled pet owners who meet program guidelines in times of need. We offer pet retention programs, adoption options, services and education and sustainable programs that enhance companion animal ownership. We are dedicated to keeping pets healthy and happy by keeping them with the people who love and need them most. In tough economic times, some of us need a helping hand, but not a handout. That's what Midwest Pets For Life is all about!



Ani-Meals

Our Ani-Meals program targets citizens with disabilities and those who are homebound. We also assist people who have fallen on hard times, due to no fault of their own. This is an assistance program...not a total care program. We provide pet food and litter for up to 5 months. At the end of the 5th month, the client can re-apply for the program on a case by case basis. All pets on the Ani-Meals program MUST BE spayed or neutered by the end of the fifth month. If this requirement is not met, the re-application **WILL NOT** be renewed. Program enrollees **MUST** meet specific criteria to take part in this program.

Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinics

Our low-cost spay/neuter program is held once a month at a convenient location and is available to everyone. A licensed veterinarian provides these services. All cats are welcome and we also partner with a local vet clinic to provide spay and neuter voucher services to dogs and cats. We look forward to starting on-site spay/neuter in the coming months.

Vaccination and Microchip Clinics

On quarterly vaccination/microchip clinic days, a licensed veterinarian is on-site providing low-cost vaccinations, nail trims, dewormer, microchips and flea and tick treatment (when available). Please contact us or visit our Facebook page for clinic dates.

Cat Surrender Options

When **all** other avenues have been exhausted and the owner passes away or is no longer able to care for the pet, our no-kill organization will possibly take the pet, provided it is altered, up-to-date on vaccinations and the pet owner can provide veterinary records. The pet must also be adoptable and an intake form **MUST** be filled out in advance of the animal being accepted by Midwest Pets. Intake will depend on available space.
